

PARAMOUNT RULES OF THE ROAD

- 1. At its sole discretion, Paramount Resources Ltd. reserves the right to set seasonal load restrictions and to impose temporary road bans as road conditions warrant.
- 2. At its sole discretion, Paramount Resources Ltd. reserves the right to impose temporary road bans, as road conditions warrant. While the road bans are in effect, a fee per load shall be levied, above and beyond all other road use fees.
- 3. If weather conditions change after a move notification is granted, additional contact is required to discuss the road condition.
- 4. Grantee must ensure that all Contractor's and Sub-Contractor's carry a copy of the Master Road Use Agreement and associated Addendum in an effort to eliminate any unnecessary delays to the User.
- 5. All loads hauled on Paramount Resources Ltd. roads shall conform to Alberta Transportation Rules and Guidelines.
- 6. Obey all posted warning, stop, speed, and regulation signs. Driving over the posted speed limit on any Paramount road will result in a fine and may result in loss of road use privileges.
- 7. All heavy loads shall slow to 20 km/h when crossing bridges. Posted bridge load ratings must not be exceeded.
- 8. Tire chains may only be used during adverse winter/frozen/slippery conditions. Repairs for road damages resulting from continued use of chains when not required will be the responsibility of the user.
- 9. No stopping or parking on road except in the case of an emergency.
- 10. All accidents, incidents, and near misses must be reported immediately to Paramount Resources Ltd. personnel with a follow-up investigation report.
- 11. All vehicles must slow down when meeting on-coming traffic or when meeting or passing a grader.
- 12. All vehicles must travel with their headlights on at all times.
- 13. When hauling large and/or wide load, flashing beacons will be used at all times.
- 14. Whenever possible, all heavy, slow loads shall allow traffic to pass when safe to do so.
- 15. If more than one big truck is on the road, then a reasonable spacing between trucks must be administered. This will be contingent upon the time of day, road conditions, road traffic, and visibility. (Driver Safety is the foremost goal.)
- 16. All garbage must be secured in the back of vehicles so it cannot blow out.
- 17. Practice defensive driving and extend common courtesy to all road users
- 18. Use of firearms on or adjacent to the road is strictly prohibited.
- 19. Grantee must provide signage and road control (if required) at their cost.
