

Kaybob Area Incident Update: March 31, 2017

Actions taken between March 17, 2017 and March 30, 2017 to remediate the spill included:

- Sampling and Monitoring:
 - Continued water sampling activities and field screening from selected areas
- Water Management Activities:
 - Staged pumps and hoses for fresh water flushing as well as water diversion and recovery
 - Pumped recovered water into on-site storage tanks
 - Completed and tested 2-9 injection facilities. The 2-9 disposal well is now operational
- Wildlife Monitoring:
 - Continued daily monitoring for wildlife sightings
 - Checked and maintained wildlife deterrents
- Water Control and Containment:
 - Inspected aqua dams to ensure effectiveness. All aqua dams are operational
 - Conducted ongoing inspection and maintenance of existing booms
- Other:
 - We are working closely with the Alberta Energy Regulator and are in ongoing communication with them. We will continue to do so throughout the clean-up and remediation of the site

Subject to weather conditions, actions planned for the week beginning April 1, 2017 include:

- Continue analytical updates from delineation and monitoring points (water samples)
- Monitor and maintain trenches, recover fluids (if any) and haul to disposal site
- Conduct water sampling and field screening from selected areas
- Continue to inspect and maintain the booms
- Continue to monitor for wildlife activity and maintain wildlife deterrents
- Continue recovering water into on-site storage tanks and 2-9 disposal facility
- Continue diverting fresh water around the release area
