Paramount will be monitoring these roads closely with road patrols throughout this time. It is the Grantee's responsibility to notify all field staff, contractors, engineers and other employees covered under your Road Use Agreement with Paramount Resources Ltd of the contents of this letter. Damages resulting from continued use in wet or unfrozen conditions will be the responsibility of the road user and may result in lost road use privileges and additional charges to repair the damages. All other road rules and regulations still apply.
